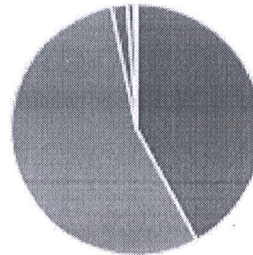

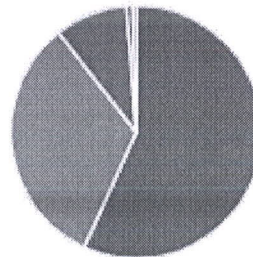

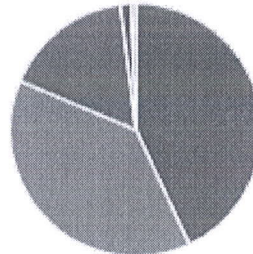

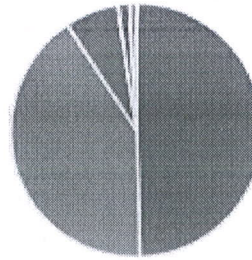
12. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

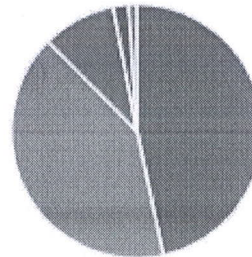
13. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

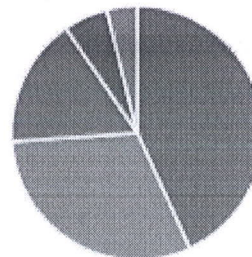

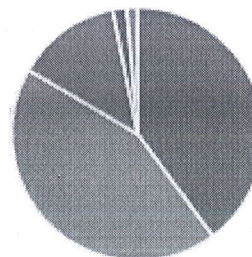

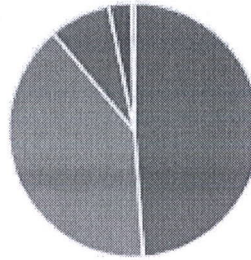

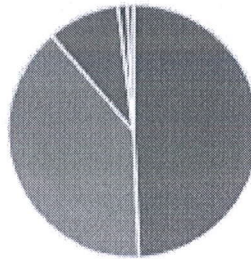

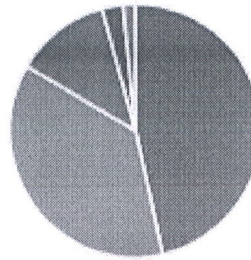

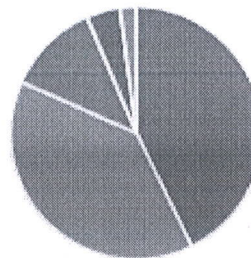

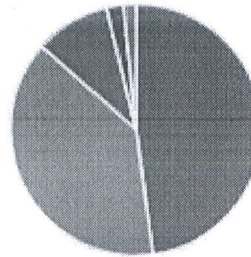

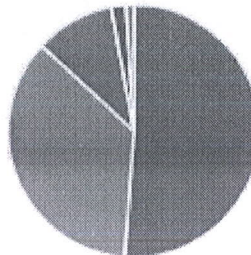

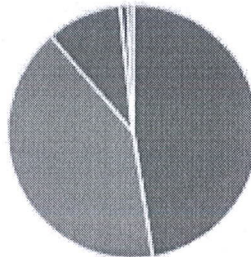

Report on Student Satisfaction Survey


Student Satisfaction Survey as stated by NAAC was collected from all the students of our institution. Out of 1911 students (I, II, III & IV year) 1355 responses were received. The students' Satisfaction Survey feedback is helpful in determining the institution's teaching and learning process. Based on the findings, it is identified that the faculty members positively associate with their students. Most students felt that the teachers covered the subject in the allotted time because they prepared ahead of time. In addition, effective teaching methods and the use of modern tools and more illustrations of concepts through outstanding examples assist them in better comprehending concepts and offer them many opportunities to learn and improve.

Most of our college students agreed that our college encourages them to participate in internships and field visits. Students stated that faculty members are unbiased when grading the answer scripts. As seen by the analysis, mentors frequently monitor their mentees. The mentees strength & weakness are discovered and fully supported by the mentors.
