**7. Introduction of Honours (18 extra credits earned from same programme), Minors (18 extra credits earned from other programme) and Professional Electives from verticals.**

- The members enquired the reason behind Absolute Grading system for Laboratory for which Dr.S.Kalyani, Former CoE explained the revised amendment received from Anna University regarding the Absolute Grading System for Laboratory Courses as per representations from Colleges. The members suggested implementing absolute grading for laboratory and analyzing two years data and coming up with conclusion for future follow up.
- The members suggested avoiding “optional”, “Skip” terms. The members opined that the online courses may be included in the Professional elective basket.
- The members also added to have an assessment for MOOC courses by the course instructor in a particular ratio either 40:60 / 50:50.
- The members suggested to frame the course syllabus for Minor degree programmes in an elementary level so that there is no prerequisite to learn the course by the students. All the members discussed and insisted to offer one minor degree courses from each Department. The members suggested avoiding advanced courses for Minor degree.

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ The members enquired about the syllabus and assessment to be done for Tamils and Technology (Audit Course) for which Member Secretary explained the syllabus content and quoted the provision suggested by Anna University for other state students / languages to write the exam in English. Also he informed that it is not considered for CGPA calculation.</li><li>➤ The members suggested changing the title of the Mandatory Employability Enhancement Course (Aptitude &amp; Reasoning) as “Quantitative Aptitude” since the syllabus content is not much relevant with reasoning.</li><li>➤ Member Secretary explained in detail the eligibility criteria to take up the Honours degree by the students like mandatory CGPA of 7.5 upto 4<sup>th</sup> semester and maintain it at the end of programme and all of the courses in their programme of study should be cleared on their first attempt.</li><li>➤ The members suggested having different evaluation system under autonomy like including assessment for self-study component (L T P C). Also they suggested to modify the terminology, “Minor Project” as “Cornerstone Project” and “Major project” as “Capstone project” for understanding its better value.</li><li>➤ The members enquired about the mini project assessment for which Member secretary explained that the same mini project is been assessed at different stages with rubrics as decided by the course instructor.</li><li>➤ The members enquired whether the internal mark that can be carried out throughout the programme for arrear courses. As per the Anna University norms, it is decided that the internal mark will be considered for one regular attempt and one arrear attempt.</li><li>➤ The members suggested to represent Anna University regarding the contradiction in CGPA cut off (7.5 and above) for Honours Degree since it is less compared to “First Class with Distinction” (8.5 and above) category.</li></ul>

Member Secretary proposed the following Amendment in PG R2020:

**Clause - R10.1:**

Continuous Assessment throughout the semester and End Semester Examinations. For Theory courses, the continuous assessment will carry 40 Marks and End semester Examinations will carry 60 marks. For practical courses and project work, the continuous assessment will carry 60 Marks and End semester Examinations will each carry 40 marks. Each Theory integrated with Laboratory courses or Laboratory integrated with Theory courses shall be evaluated for a maximum of 100 marks as shown below.

**Clause - R10.2.1:**

The End Semester Examinations (Theory, Theory-cum-Practical & Practical) of three hours duration will be conducted by the Controller of Examinations between November and December during the Odd semesters and between April and May during Even semesters.

**Clause - R11.4:**

The evaluation of Project Work for Phase-I & Phase-II shall be done independently in the respective semesters. The Head of the Department will constitute a review committee of three faculty members for each specialization. Three reviews will be conducted during the semester by the review committee. The student will make a presentation before the review committee on the progress of the Project. The total marks obtained in the three reviews shall be reduced to 60 marks and shall be rounded to the next integer.

**Clause - R11.4.1:**

The Project report will carry a maximum of 20 marks. The project report shall be submitted as per the approved guidelines of the Institute from time to time. The viva-voce examination shall carry 20 marks. Marks are awarded to each student based on the performance in the viva-voce examination.

**Clause - R12.1:**

The relative grading is applicable to ONLY those students who have passed the examination as per the passing requirements enumerated above. For those students who have not passed the examination, Reappearance (U) shall be awarded as shown in the below Table. For those students who have passed the course, the relative grading shall be done. The evolved relative grading method normalizes the results data using the BOX-COX transformation method and computes the grade range for each course separately and awards the grade to each student. For a given course, if the students' strength is greater than 30, the relative grading method shall be adopted.
